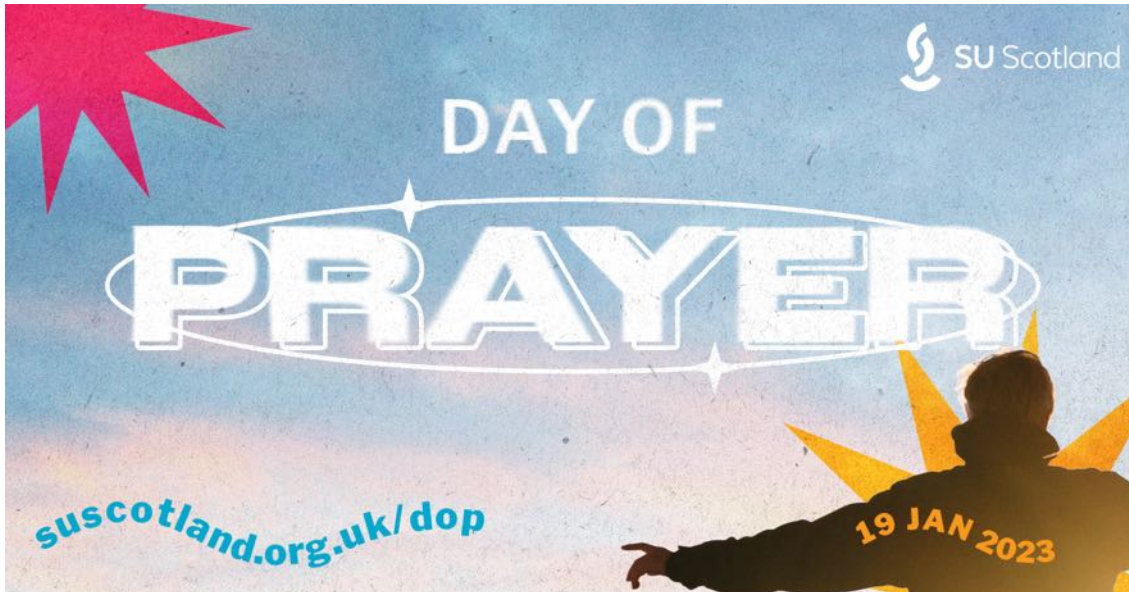


New trustees (and Board Chair) needed!

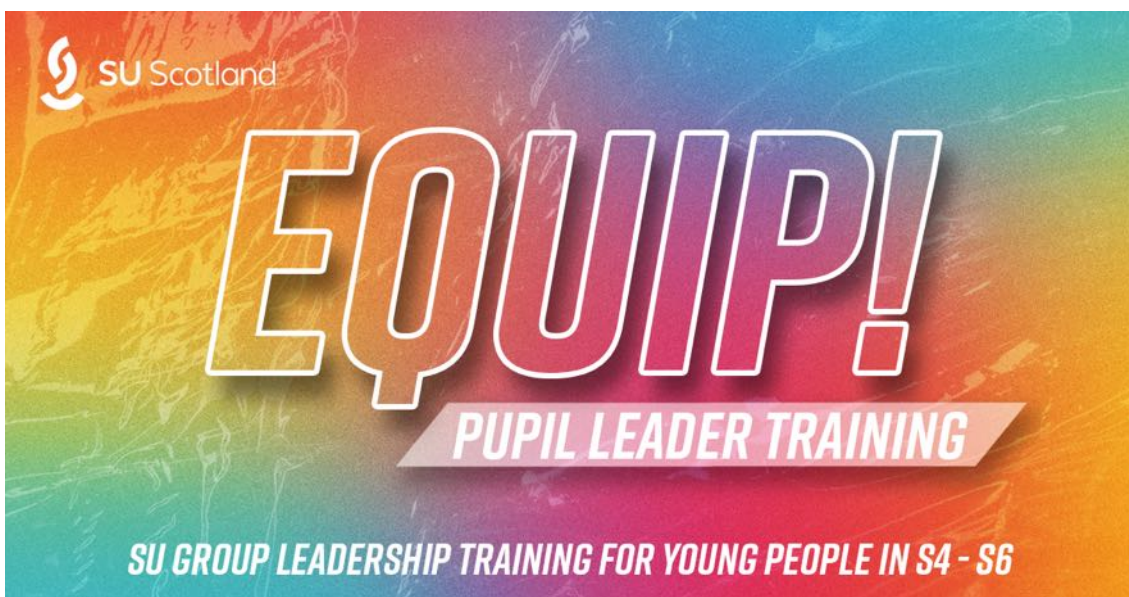
Day of Prayer
